Careful Thinking/Argumentation (20 pts) Arguments are well-supported, without any unsupported generalizations or misinterpretations. Background information provides context for evidence and assertions Commentary and evaluation makes complex connections between themes and texts Commentary and evaluation shows deep insight and complex thinking Focus remains on topic in every paragraph Opposing or conflicting arguments are presented fairly Conclusions reached are logical and naturally follow from the arguments and evidence in your paper There is ample evidence from various reputable sources to support your claim Evidence used is relevant and accurate, and carefully chosen and cut for maximum impact and relevance Quotes are set up correctly and analyzed succinctly and insightfully Sentence Craft, Style, Proofreading, Bibliography (10 pts) Tone, voice, and point of view are always appropriate to the purpose and audience Active verbs and precise nouns add clarity Sentences are focused, with concrete subjects (NO passive voice) Sentence length adds variety with no awkward or unfocused constructions Quotes and evidence are introduced and seamlessly integrated No errors, typos, etc. Ready for publication. In-text citations are "appropriately used and formatted correctly" (Fisher 78).
