

# Senior Thesis: MLA Formatting Checklist

---

## Purpose:

Use this checklist to double-check the formatting for your final paper.

## Title Page

- \_\_\_ Research question is in 16 point font, italics, centered
- \_\_\_ First and last name, 16 point font, bold, centered
- \_\_\_ Senior Project Advisor: Their name. 16 point font, centered
- \_\_\_ 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Humanities, Animas High School, Submission Date. Centered, 16 point font, all on different lines
- \_\_\_ There is a blank page between the title page and beginning of your essay text

## Margins, Font, Pages

- \_\_\_ Font is Times New Roman
- \_\_\_ Font is 12 point
- \_\_\_ Margins are set to 1 inch all the way around
- \_\_\_ Entire paper is double-spaced
- \_\_\_ Insert page numbers at the bottom of each page
- \_\_\_ Insert a header with your last name and the page number at the top of each page

## Titles and Headers

- \_\_\_ If you want a clever title for your paper, center it on the first page
- \_\_\_ Headings are correctly phrased, centered, and bolded

- \_\_\_ Any sub-headings you use are justified left and italicized

## Quotes

- \_\_\_ All quotes have quotation marks
- \_\_\_ All quotes are correctly cited using MLA in-text citations
- \_\_\_ Any quote longer than 4 lines is block quoted (started on a new line, entire quote is indented 1 inch from the left margin)

## Appendixes

If you have any Appendixes (for graphs, data tables, etc.), they should follow the following format. See Shannon Etz's sample paper for a visual of how to do this.

- \_\_\_ Each appendix starts on a new page after the conclusion of the paper
- \_\_\_ Each appendix has a centered, bolded title: **Appendix 1**, **Appendix 2**, etc.
- \_\_\_ Each figure in your appendix is clearly labeled

## Bibliography

- \_\_\_ Bibliography starts on a new page
- \_\_\_ Bibliography is title Bibliography. 12 point, centered, bolded
- \_\_\_ Bibliography is alphabetized by the first word in each citation
- \_\_\_ After the first line of each citation, following lines are indented by ½ inch
- \_\_\_ All entries are fully cited using MLA format
